CAPITAL CASES

Lead trial counsel: counsel must have: (1) At least five years of criminal litigation experience; AND (2) Experience as lead counsel for the defense in a jury trial of at least one capital case OR experience as co-counsel for the defense in a jury trial for at least two capital cases; AND (3) Within ten years preceding appointment, experience as lead counsel in a jury trial of at least one murder or aggravated murder case OR within five years preceding appointment, experience as lead counsel in three aggravated or first or second degree felony jury trials. **Training**: (1) Must meet qualifications of Supreme Court Rules for Appointment of Counsel in Capital Cases (formerly Rule 20); AND (2) Must appear on list of attorneys qualified to accept appointments in capital cases promulgated by the Commission on Appointment of Counsel in Capital Cases (formerly the Rule 20 Commission); OR (3) Must have a waiver of prequalification issued by the Commission on Appointment of Counsel in Capital Cases (formerly the Rule 20 Commission).

Trial co-counsel: counsel must have: (1) At least three years of criminal litigation experience; AND (2) Within 10 years preceding appointment, experience as co-counsel in one murder or aggravated murder jury trial OR within five years preceding appointment, experience as lead counsel in one first or second degree felony jury trial OR within five years preceding appointment, experience as lead or co-counsel in at least two felony jury or civil jury trials. **Training** (1) Must meet qualifications of Supreme Court Rules for Appointment of Counsel in Capital Cases (formerly Rule 20); AND (2) Must appear on list of attorneys qualified to accept appointments in capital cases promulgated by the Commission on Appointment of Counsel in Capital Cases(formerly the Rule 20 Commission); OR (3) Must have a waiver of pre-qualification issued by the Commission on Appointment of Counsel in Capital Cases(formerly the Rule 20 Commission).

ADULT APPEALS

____Misdemeanors and 4th and 5th degree felonies: in lieu of required training, at least one year experience as an attorney. **Training**: (1) Minimum six hours CLE in criminal or appellate practice and procedure; OR (2) Successful completion of clinical education program focusing on appellate practice.
