

The Clermont County Court of Common Pleas - General Division orders Court Services to check the temperature of all persons (employees and general public) who attempt entry into the Common Pleas courthouse. Court Services shall ask each person entering if "they are feeling well today?" and "have you been in contact with anyone who might be a carrier of the coronavirus?" and shall make other inquiries as deemed necessary to determine whether a person should be denied access for the protection of the staff and other persons in the Courthouse.

This order shall take effect on Monday, March 23, 2020, and remain in effect until further order of this Court.



The Clermont County Court of Common Pleas - General Division orders Court Services to limit public access to the Courthouse to the following: 1) In a criminal case, counsel, the defendant and the defendant's immediate family, the victim and the victim's immediate family, and any subpoenaed witness. 2) In a civil case, counsel, the plaintiff and the plaintiff's immediate family, the defendant and the defendant's immediate family, and any subpoenaed witness. 3) Persons who are reporting to the Probation Department. 4) Persons who need access to the Clerk of Courts Office. 5) Staff and other persons authorized by the court to have entry.

This order shall take effect on Monday, March 23, 2020, and shall remain in effect until further order of this Court.
