

**Order Regarding Garnishments,  
Attachments, and Replevin Proceedings**

Pursuant to the directions of the Chief Justice as to the operation of Ohio courts during the state and national emergency currently existing related to COVID-19, and exercising the authority of Administrative Judge, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. The Clerk shall accept new filings as to garnishments, attachments, and replevins. Motions and other matters submitted in previously filed proceedings will be filed of record when they are submitted to the Clerk by counsel or self-represented parties.
2. New filings, and motions and other matters submitted in previously filed proceedings, as to garnishments, attachments and replevins, will be automatically stayed as of the time they are submitted to the Clerk's office.
3. No court orders regarding garnishments, attachments, or replevins will be issued during this emergency, or until further order of the Administrative Judge.
4. No hearings regarding garnishments, attachments, or replevins will be scheduled or held during this emergency, or until further order of the Administrative Judge.
5. All time deadlines established by the Revised Code or the Local Rules as to garnishments, attachments, or replevins are tolled pursuant to order of the Chief Justice of the State of Ohio.
