Effective June 2, 2021 at 12:01 am, the Governor and the Director of the Ohio Department of Health are lifting all emergency and public health orders regarding the COVID-19 Pandemic except those related to congregate living and healthcare settings. Accordingly, the Order filed June 3, 2020 Related to Access to the Courthouse and its Continuing and Safe Operation in Response to the COVID-19 Pandemic and Public Health Emergency is hereby rescinded effective June 2, 2021 at 12:01 am. The Court of Common Pleas, General Division will resume normal operations at that time, subject to the following requirements:

1. Fully vaccinated individuals are not required to wear a facial covering in the courthouse.
2. Individuals who have not been fully vaccinated are required to wear a facial covering which covers both the mouth and nose while in the courthouse. Proof of vaccination


may be required by court staff and/or court security. Failure to provide proof of vaccination will result in a facial covering being required, or expulsion from the courthouse.

3. Individuals entering the courthouse shall be subject to a non-invasive, non-contact temperature check at the security checkpoint. Anyone with a temperature above 100.4 ° F will not be permitted to enter the courthouse.


The Court continues to encourage employees and anyone entering the courthouse to be respectful of the personal space of others and to exercise proper hygiene and sanitization. The Court will continue to have hand sanitizer available throughout the courthouse. The Court will permit anyone who desires to wear a facial covering in the courthouse to do so.

Each Judge retains the discretion to impose specific requirements to be followed in their courtroom. Any such requirements shall be posted on the Court's website, and shall be available at the security checkpoint.


